The design competition is aimed at contributing to the development of the design skills in the furniture sector, and the initiative aims to complement the development of a design course, currently done with Fibre Processing and Manufacturing Seta. Design skills can promote innovation, and be used as a creative instrument to promote product differentiation and new product development. The competition is used as an immediate tool to promote and encourage interest in furniture industry, and to attract upcoming designers to the industry.

The main objectives of the design competition are:

- To raise and nurture design capabilities in the local furniture industry
 Raising the image of the Furniture Manufacturing Industry in South Africa
- To grow the industry's competitiveness and attract designers to the industry
- Re-position industry for high value-added products Attract design skill to the industry

Every year, the dti buys floor space and build a stand in a selected show in February/ March of every year, just before our financial year end, and show case the work of the finalists and to host the prize giving event. A total of 12 finalists, 6 students and 6 manufacturers, are invited. The competition is gaining momentum and is now in its sixth year, and continues to attract attention from students and manufacturers alike.
